The Oak is in The Acorn is a non-profit, 501c(3) ministry that was founded in Oroville, California by young adults with a desire to share the love of Christ with their family, friends, co-workers and community. Since 2009, the time of its establishment, the ministry has shared the Gospel in many different cities throughout North America through sponsored Gospel Workers, evangelistic crusades, media, and by a health food and Christian bookstore. As the city of Oroville continues to see rising problems with drugs and alcohol, The Oak ministry has a goal to share the love of Christ with people in the community through the avenue of recovery. The vehicle with which we plan to share Christ's love is The Maranatha House.

The Maranatha House has four goals. The immediate goal is to have a Sober Living Environment, which will give the needed opportunity to those who are in recovery, from either drugs or alcohol, to help be reintegrated back into society to be positive members of the community. In the future, we plan to establish a Drug and Alcohol Treatment Center and an Inpatient Detox Clinic. The final goal of The Maranatha House will be to provide a Homeless Shelter to assist Oroville with the rising number of people who are suffering from homelessness. The main goal for The Maranatha House is to introduce those who are suffering from drug or alcohol addictions to Jesus, and to His rehabilitating and restoring power.
